<u>Definition</u>: a person who believes in forceful action (as a mass demonstration) for political purposes (ac-tiv-ism)

equal·i-ty

<u>Definition</u>: the quality or state of being equal : the quality or state of having the same rights, social status, etc.

ex-trem-ism ik-str-miz-m - (noun)

<u>Definition</u>: belief in and support for extreme ideas especially in politics
