| Type of Genre | DefinitionImaginative or made up writing; Examples: adventure <br> stories, science fiction/fantasy, mystery, horror, <br> romance, realistic fiction, and historical fiction |

|  | A story made up and handed down by the common <br> people; it is often told orally by story tellers |
|  | A play or script |
|  | Writing that usually involves figurative language and <br> lines that have rhythm and sometimes rhyme |
|  | Writing that is true and based on fact; Examples: <br> biographies, autobiographies |
